



## **Senator Thune and Representative Peterson cosponsor Resolutions Opposing Carbon Tax**

Missouri River Energy Services (MRES) recognizes Senator John Thune (R-S.D.) and Representative Collin Peterson (D-Minn.) for their co-sponsorship of resolutions opposing a carbon tax.

Resolutions were introduced in both the Senate and House opposing a new carbon tax on fuels used to generate electricity and fuel transportation – both resolutions come amid ongoing discussions of a carbon tax as Congress looks for new revenues in the “fiscal cliff” negotiations.

Senator Thune and Representative Peterson both co-sponsored their respective resolutions opposing the tax. The resolutions stressed the reasons the tax would be harmful to the American families and businesses.
